RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. **THE POINTER CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY.**
3. **SUBSTITUTES** can be accepted for **BITCHES IN SEASON** providing the substitute is eligible for the Stake and no reserves are standing. In every case a veterinary Certificate must be produced or the bitch made available for inspection.
4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
5. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
6. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes, and the circumstances surrounding them, will be reported to The Kennel Club.
7. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of The Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
8. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
9. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and **AT RISK** if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
10. **WELFARE OF DOGS.** An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
11. Out of respect for the generosity of our host, competitors should try to ensure their dogs are competent and are capable of maintaining the standard required.
12. Any **BITCH IN SEASON** must be removed from the Ground and from the Trial immediately.
13. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES** are dogs to be run on the Trial Grounds before the Trials. The Owner(s) of any dogs(s) so found will have his/their entries disqualified. His/their entry fee(s) forfeited, and future entries refused.
14. **THE POINTER CLUB** cannot accept responsibility for injury, loss, or damage to person or property however occasioned.
15. **ALL PERSONS** attending this meeting must consider themselves under the control of the Field Trial Secretary, Chief Steward, Stewards and Officials of the Club. Persons attending Field Trials should conduct themselves and be appropriately dressed according to the shooting fields practice and custom.
16. The sum of £2.00 per entry will be returned should any Stake be abandoned due to adverse weather conditions.
17. Photographs and videos may only be taken with the permission of the Chief Steward.

CUPS & TROPHIES

FIRST DAY – Thursday 7th September 2017
(Maximum number of runners permitted 45 dogs)

STAKE 1 NOVICE POINTER & SETTER STAKE: A Stake which is confined to dogs which have not gained a First, Second or Third in Open stakes or a First or two Seconds in All-Aged, Novice or Puppy stakes prior to the close of entries.

STAKE 2 OPEN POINTER STAKE for Pointers of any age.

SECOND DAY- Friday 8th September 2017

STAKE 3 OPEN POINTER & SETTER STAKE For Pointers and Setters of any age (limited to 40 entries)

- Preference in the draw for Open Stakes shall be given in the following order:
- a) Members’ dogs which have gained a First, Second, or Third award in an Open Stake or a First or two Second awards in All-Aged, Novice, or Puppy stakes.
 - b) Non-Members’ dogs as in (a) above.
 - c) Members’ dogs, which have gained other awards.
 - d) Non-Members’ dogs as in (c) above.
 - e) Other dogs.

The foregoing awards must have been gained in a stake qualifying for entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book. If a competitor enters more than one similarly qualified dog, his first ‘preferred’ dog must be balloted for in the normal manner. ‘Second’ and subsequent dogs must then be placed in separate ballots before entries are drawn from other categories.

Stakes 2 and 3 qualify towards the title of Field Trial Champion and towards entry in the Pointer and Setter Champion Stake

SHOW GUNDOG WORKING CERTIFICATE

Any Pointer or Setter, which has won a Challenge Certificate under Kennel Club Rules may be tested for a S.G.W.C. on payment of Members £15.00 Non-Members £20.00
(This will be run before the Open Stake on the second day)

THE ASSYNT CUP	For the winner of the Open (Pointer and Setter) Stake: Presented by E. H. Vestey Esq.
THE VAUX SILVER TANKARD	For the winner of the Novice Stake: Presented by Vaux Breweries Ltd.
THE FLEETSTALK TROPHY	For the winner of the Open Stake for Pointers: Presented by Mr & Mrs S Lound
THE LUNE PRINCE TROPHY	For the Best Performance by a Pointer, handled by the Owner, which has not won less than Reserve Prize at a Championship Show in the classes Minor Puppy to Open: Presented by the late Mrs P Bates

Dogs must gain at least a Certificate of Merit to be eligible for any Cup or special prize

ENTRY FEES:

Owners from the republic of Ireland may pay their fees in Sterling on the morning of the stake entered.
